The examination will be objective in nature and based on the prescribed topics. It will be conducted in both English and Hindi.

The duration of the examination will be three hours.

The question paper will consist of 100 multiple-choice questions, carrying a total of 100 marks.

Negative marking shall apply: $\frac{1}{4}$ mark will be deducted for each incorrect response.

Eligibility Criteria

The Scholarship Entrance Test is open to candidates who meet any of the following eligibility conditions:

Graduates who are:

Eligible to apply for competitive examinations, or

Intending to begin preparation for such examinations, or

Currently engaged in preparation for these examinations.

Undergraduate Students who are:

Currently enrolled in the second or final year of a recognized undergraduate program in any stream (Science, Arts, or Commerce).

Senior Secondary Students, i.e., those who have:

Successfully completed 10+2 or an equivalent qualification from a recognized board or institution.

These categories of candidates are eligible to apply for the Scholarship Entrance Test designed for aspirants of Banking, SSC, and various State-level Public Service Commission (PSC) Examinations.
