

B.Ed. (Bachelor of Education)

Examination Structure:

The examination will be objective in nature and based on the prescribed syllabus. It will be conducted in both English and Hindi. The duration of the examination shall be three hours.

The question paper will comprise 100 multiple-choice questions, with a total of 100 marks. Negative marking will be applicable, with one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) of a mark deducted for each incorrect response.

Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates who meet any of the following conditions are eligible to apply for the Scholarship Entrance Test for B.Ed. :

Those who are eligible to apply for the B.Ed. program;

Those who intend to prepare for the B.Ed. entrance examination;

Those currently preparing for the B.Ed. course;

Those who are already enrolled in a B.Ed. program at any recognized college or university.

Furthermore, candidates who have completed graduation or its equivalent, or who are currently enrolled in the second or final year of an undergraduate program in any of the three streams—Science, Arts, or Commerce—are also eligible to apply for the B.Ed. Entrance Scholarship Test.
