

## UPSC (NDA, CDS, CAPF AND OTHERS)

- Examination Structure:

The examination will be objective in nature and based on the prescribed topics. It will be conducted in both English and Hindi.

The duration of the examination will be three hours.

The question paper will consist of 100 multiple-choice questions, carrying a total of 100 marks.

Negative marking shall apply:  $\frac{1}{4}$  mark will be deducted for each incorrect response.

### Eligibility Criteria:

Graduates who are eligible to apply for UPSC examinations such as CDS, CAPF, and others are eligible to apply for the entrance test.

Students who are eligible, planning to prepare, or currently preparing for UPSC examinations such as NDA, CDS, CAPF, and others, may apply for the UPSC Scholarship Entrance Test.

Candidates who have completed graduation or are currently in the 2nd or final year of an undergraduate program in Science, Arts, or Commerce streams are also eligible to apply for the UPSC (CDS, CAPF, and others) Scholarship Entrance Test.
