

Common-Law Admission Test (CLAT)

Exam Structure:

The examination will be of objective type based on the prescribed topics, and conducted in English and Hindi.

The duration of the examination will be 3 hours.

Negative marking will be applicable: $\frac{1}{4}$ mark will be deducted for each incorrect answer.

The paper will consist of 100 questions, carrying a total of 100 marks.

Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates who are eligible to appear for the CLAT examination, or those who are intending to begin their preparation, as well as those who are currently preparing for CLAT, are eligible to apply for the CLAT Scholarship Entrance Test.
