

IIM- CAT (Common Admission Test)

Syllabus and Test Pattern :

The paper will be objective-type and based on the following topics, in English or Hindi. The duration of the exam will be 3 hours. One-fourth of a mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.

The paper will consist of 100 questions, with a total of 100 marks.

- Eligibility Criteria:

Graduate candidates or students currently in their 2nd or final year (from any of the three streams - Science, Arts, or Commerce) are eligible to apply for the IIM-CAT Entrance Scholarship Test.

Students who are eligible to appear for the IIM-CAT exam, those who are planning to prepare, or those who are already preparing for it, can apply for the IIM-CAT Scholarship Entrance Test.
